Course Objective: This course is an introduction to the fundamental principles of managerial accounting. At the end of the course students should be able to:

- Demonstrate increase in knowledge of cost systems, cost-volume-profit analysis, variable costing, budgeting, performance evaluations and other topics used in making managerial decisions in business through pre and post-tests.
- Apply course topics through completion of in-class and homework exercises, problems and special activities.
- Demonstrate the ability to apply concepts learned in class to real-world companies through the completion of a project.
