Description:

ART 2605 Computer Graphics (4)

The work in this course incorporates basic design and compositional skills utilizing a variety of software and electronic media, emphasizing Adobe Creative Suite, Macromedia Flash, and Corel Painter. Prerequisite: ART 1205 with a grade of C- or better, or permission of instructor. Satisfies the Fine Arts option for the B.A. degree. Offered every spring semester.

This grade will be based on participation and attendance (the opening) to one of the scheduled art shows this semester in the Cullis/Gaylon Galleries (Dates TBA)

20% Final Exam

Your final exam will be an I-Movie compilation of the projects you have completed during the class. The movie will contain text and music and should reflect a high level of skill.
