Notes/Clarifications

Offense: New offensive coordinator **Alexander Wright** looks to help jump start a Pride offense that was rated last in the USA South. Senior **Justin Roberson** is slated to be GC's starter for the third straight year. He posted his best year (1047 yards, 10 TDs) as a junior. Receiver **Kenyatta Campbell** (18.2 yards per catch) returns, but The Pride needs to replace RB **Quentin Caldwell**, Greensboro's second all-time rusher.

Defense: GC has holes to fill on defense, but not in the backfield. The veteran Pride DB unit returns all of its starters, including senior **James Matthews**. Exciting sophomore **JR Hair** is also back in the defensive secondary.

Special Teams: Junior **Chris Palme** is expected to handle the place kicking duties. He was 6-13 on FG attempts in 2004. Palme converted two field goals of 40 yards or more. Greensboro seeks a replacement for first team all-conference punter **John Sheridan** (36.9 average). **JR Hair** (9.8 average, one TD in '04) is expected to return punts for The Pride.

GC and IAA Foes: Greensboro begins the year at NCAA Division IAA Davidson. The only other IAA foe the program has played is Jacksonville. The Pride lost at Jacksonville, 47-41, in 2 OTs in '99. The Pride fell to the Dolphins, 35-14, at Jamieson Stadium in '98.
