

Club and Organization Good Standing Requirements

Required Actions

___ At the beginning of each semester, submit a **Student Organization Officer Contact Form**, by August 31st in the fall, and January 31st in the spring.

___ Confirm with the Office of Student Activities at the beginning of each semester that the governing documents have not changed/alterd or provide the most recent documents.

___ Attend Officer Charge each semester (September 18 for fall, and TBA for spring).

___ Complete at least one community service project each semester.

___ Provide one activity for the entire Greensboro College campus or participate in one campus-wide event per semester.

___ One representative must attend each Club Leadership Series. This representative can be ANYONE in the organization. Any one person cannot represent more than 2 organizations without prior approval by the Director of Student Activities.

Suggested Actions

___ Check the club mailbox in the student organization workroom in the Reynolds Center at least once a week.

___ Participate in Club Carnival each semester.

___ Participate in Craven Cup Pride Challenge.

Sanctions/Budgets



Any club/organization that fails to complete any single required action will be placed on probation for one semester.



Two consecutive semesters of probation may result in the club being tabled by SGA.



Clubs placed on probation will be required to meet with the Secretary of Clubs and the Director of Student Activities.



The Secretary of Clubs, the Secretary of Finance, and the Director of Student Activities will determine if a club may be removed from probationary status.



Each club fulfilling ALL required actions will be entitled to receive an operating budget of at least \$100/semester.



Clubs may petition the Finance Committee for an increase in their operating budget.



The Finance Committee has the right to deny any and all budget requests of a club placed on probation.



All new clubs are required to meet with the Secretary of Clubs and the Director of Student Activities on a regular basis. During their first semester, they are expected to work only on their organization and planning for the following semester. They will not be required to meet the Good Standing requirements within the first semester. Their requests may be granted on "good faith."
